3.61 crore man days generated under

MGNREGA in current financial year

MGNREGA has created 3.61 crore man days in the current financial year, securing an average of 61.5 man days. Tripura has been ranked 3rd in the country in terms of average man day creation. Yesterday, Dr. Sandeep R Rathore, Secretary of Rural Development Department highlighting the success and progress of various project has given this information in a press conference at Secretariat Press Conference Hall. He said that in the fiscal year 2023-2024, the central government has allocated an amount of Rs. 1065.64 crore and the state government has provided Rs 75.12 crore for the MGNREGA. Till now Rs. 1021.75 crore have been spent. He also added that the central government has approved a labor budget of 3 crore man days for the state in the next financial year. As a result of special initiative by the state government, 1.70 lakh eligible families have been sanctioned Pucca houses since 2022 and 2.91 lakh houses have been constructed under this scheme. The central government has praised the state government for this achievement. The state government has spent around Rs. 4700 crore on Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (rural) and about 63 percent of this expenditure i.e about three thousand crore rupees has been spent in the previous fiscal year.

In the press conference, secretary highlighted the achievement of Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission in the financial year 2023-24 and said that on March 1st, 2024 Killa Mahila Cluster Level Federation under TRLM got GI registration for RISA.
