<u>Virtual inauguration of 35 Oxygen Plants from Hrishikesh, Uttarakhand</u>

Central government is working to set up AIIMS in every state to bring advancement in health services: Prime Minister



The central government is working to implement the plan of setting up AIIMS in every state to bring advancement in health services across the country. Plans are to set up medical colleges in each district, enunciated Prime Minister Narendra Modi after virtually inaugurating 35 Oxygen Plants in every state and union territories from Hrishikesh, Uttarakhand. The oxygen plants were built with the funds of PM Cares. The virtual inauguration programme was directly telecasted from 4no. Lecture Hall of AGMC. In the same programme, PSA oxygen plant of 1,000 LPM capacity was also inaugurated inside Agartala Government Medical College and GBP campus. Apart from that, second oxygen plant of 900 LPM capacity was inaugurated by Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb inside GBP hospital campus. Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment Pratima Bhowmik was also present in the programme. After the inauguration, the Chief Minister and other guests enquired about the services provided by CTVS and Interventional Radiology section of GB hospital.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi after virtually inaugurating oxygen plants said, the central government is working on priority basis for the development of health services and infrastructure. Success has been achieved in giving services including increasing oxygen availability giving importance to health safety of the people during Covid situation. A number of plans were implemented winning over geographical and population challenges including vaccination and setting up of testing labs. Different initiatives are being successfully implemented to develop health infrastructure and set up oxygen plants from the funds of PM Cares. Different steps are being taken to develop health infrastructure in every state in the country.

The government plans to at least set up one AIIMS in every state. Targets have been taken to modernize health facilities including making availability of oxygen in hospitals of concerned areas through setting up of oxygen plants in each district. Hospitals are being prepared to provide advanced health services through modernization in health services. Prime Minister said, the central government is working to cater all kinds of services to its citizens instead of letting them plead the administration to solve their problems. Ayushman Bharat scheme is playing an important role in giving advanced treatments to financially weak families. Now because of this the whole country is reaping its benefits. During the period of present central government, importance has been given to setting up of medical colleges across the country. A great amount of success was achieved recently.
