District level TB free GP felicitated

The Gomati District TB Free Gram Panchayat felicitation program was inaugurated yesterday by the Finance Minister Pranjit Singh Roy at Rajarshi Hall, Udaipur. In his address, Finance Minister Roy emphasized the government's commitment to revamping the state's health system, highlighting the launch of schemes such as the Chief Minister Jan Arogya Yojana aimed at ensuring health services for all. He also noted the nationwide TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyan launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, which aims to make India TB-free.
