

“Prati Ghare Sushason” Campaign has started in the state

“Prati Ghare Sushason” campaign has started in the state to give the benefits of flagship schemes of the central government and various schemes of the state government to the people from the district to the gram panchayat level. The campaign will be launched in the state on September 17 on Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s birthday. The campaign will continue in the state till November 30. A high-level meeting was held for this programme at the conference hall of the Secretariat on 9 September, 2022. Chief Minister Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha presided over the meeting.
