



Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after the launch of the mission termed the mission as a ground-breaking initiative. He also added, after Prime Minister took over the government in 2014 there has been remarkable breakthrough in the health sector as compared to the previous central governments after India got its independence. Before this, there were just 7 Indian Institute of Medical Science, at present there are 23. Earlier there were 387 medical colleges in the country, at present there are 581. Number of medical students has also increased in the country from 51 thousand 348 to 85 thousand 825. Besides that, 79 thousand health & wellness centres were also reinvigorated across the country. 64 thousand crore rupees will be invested in this yojana for health infrastructure. From which 56.91 crore rupees will be invested for development of health infrastructure in Tripura. He also informed that 93 crore rupees for external Covid response plan has been sanctioned for the state. Just recently, the state received 83 crore rupees. The Chief Minister thanked the Prime Minister and congratulated citizens of the state on launch of the mission.
