Tribal Welfare Minister inaugurates award distribution ceremony at Suparibagan

A programme for distributing traditional dresses, ornaments, musical instruments and props and distribution of awards was organized by Tribal Research and Cultural Institute (TR&CI) yesterday at Sangduk Hukumu Surung Nok, Suparibagan, Agartala to promote tribal culture of the state and encourage indigenous people in different fields such as sports, culture and literature.
