Fish fingerlings released in River Manu and River Deo under PMMSY

1 lakh 80 thousand fish fingerlings have been released in River Manu and River Deo in Kumarghat under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana yesterday. With the financial assistance of National Fisheries Development Board, fish fingerlings of different species such as Rohu, Catla, Carp etc. were released in both the rivers. An awareness camp was organized at the Community Hall of Kumarghat Motorstand on the occasion yesterday. The awareness camp was inaugurated by Chairperson of Kumarghat Municipal Council Biswajit Das. Other dignitaries present there were President of Agriculture related Standing Committee of Unakoti Zilla Parishad Subhrendu Das, Deputy Director of Fisheries department Jayanta Chakraborty and Kumarghat sub-division Fisheries Supervisor Pranab Kanti Das. The guests have released the fish fingerlings at Dashamighat in Kumarghat. The main objective of the program is conserving the ecosystem of the river and creating income opportunities for those fishermen whose sole source of livelihood is fishing in the rivers.
