Launch of "Prati Ghare Sushason" campaign in the state

Government to fulfil the hopes and dreams of the Prime Minister by increasing social pension to 2000 rupees: CM

In various social pension schemes of the state government, the pension has been increased from 1000 rupees to 2000 rupees. It will be effective from this September. Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha made this announcement at the official launch of "Prati Ghare Sushason" campaign organized in Hall No. 1 of Rabindra Bhawan in Agartala on 17th September, 2022. In the inaugural programme, the Chief Minister along with other guests launched the Bengali and Kokborok campaign song, a booklet in Bengali, Kokborok and English language, Prati Ghare Sushason campaign dashboard. A documentary film outlining the campaign was screened at the programme. In the inaugural programme, the Chief Minister virtually inaugurated the 24-hour health services of North Maharanipur Primary Health Centre.

Speaking at the programme, the Chief Minister said that September 17 is the birthday of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. To commemorate Prime Minister's birthday, Prati Ghare Sushason campaign was launched on that day. This campaign will continue till November 30. He said, not only words, the present state government believes in action.
