SHGs in Manu RD Block benefitting under Aspirational District Scheme

Under Aspirational District Scheme for the year 2021-22, distribution of fish fingerlings was organised by the office of the Superintendent of Fisheries, Chailengta on 29th October during the celebration period of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav". Three Self Help Groups namely- Khabaksa Sikla Badal SHG of Dhumucherra, Pragati Fisheries Cooperative Societies of East Masli and Navodaya Cooperative Societies of West Masli all under Manu RD Block have benefitted through this. A total of 4 Ha waterbody has been brought under in fresh water fish farming in community tanks and a total of 41 thousand fingerlings were released in three water tanks in presence of Superintendents of Fisheries, Longtharai valley Subir Debbarma, Tanmoy Debbarma and other officials. It was informed that implementation of this scheme under inputs cost for two consecutive crops for freshwater fish farming in community tanks is a departmental objective that was generally sanctioned for conservation and sustainability of aquatic animals in this manner as well as to generate source of income for the rural fish farmers.
