In the review meeting, Information and Cultural Affairs Minister Sushanta Chowdhury said that this is the first time in the state that SharadSamman and Maayer Gomon programme will be organized under the initiative of the Information and Cultural Affairs Department. This event is being organized to make the immersion ceremony memorial. Initiatives will be taken so that people from other parts of the state can also enjoy the procession. On behalf of the state government, the first, second and third prizes of rupees 50,000, 30,000 and 20,000 will be given to the clubs participating in Maayer Gomon. In the review meeting, Mayor of Agartala Municipal Corporation Deepak Majumder said that the corporation authorities have taken various measures for this year's Durga Puja immersion ceremony. From Agartala Municipalareas, participating clubs in Maayer Gomon will be given 50 thousand rupees based on theme and puja management, 50 thousand rupeesfor focusing on women empowerment and 25 thousand rupees based on 4 zonal SharadSamman awards and trophies.

In the meeting, the Director of Information and Cultural Affairs Department said that Agartala and neighboring clubs and puja committees will be awarded on 6 themes. These are best theme Puja, best Eco Friendly Puja, best Pandal Decoration Puja, best conventional Puja, best Social Work Puja, best big budget Puja. Besides, prizes will be given in 5 subjects at the district level.
