

Tribute programme on the occasion of PanditDeendayalUpadhyay's birth anniversary

PanditDeendayalUpadhyay said that the country will not be strong until the society is strong. Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) ManikSaha said this while inaugurating the tribute programme on the occasion of PanditDeendayalUpadhyay's birth anniversary organized at Rabindra Bhavan by the Department of Information and Cultural Affairs. Deputy Chief Minister JishnuDev varma, Jail Minister RamPrasad Pal, Information and Cultural Affairs Minister Sushant Chowdhury, Chairman of Tripura Industrial Development Corporation Limited Tinku Roy, Information and Cultural Affairs Department Secretary Dr. PK Chakraborty and Director Ratan Biswas were present at the programme. At the beginning of the programme, Chief Minister along with other guests paid their respects by garlanding the portrait of PanditDeendayalUpadhyay.

Explaining the significance of organizing the tributaryprogramme, Chief Minister Dr. Saha said that independent India was being run on the basis of mixed doctrines where political parties and individuals were given more importance than the people of the country. PanditDeendayalUpadhyay worked to get out of this situation and organize India as a country. Chief Minister said that according to PanditDeendayalUpadhyay everyone compliments each other in this world. So he gave utmost importance to the development of the last person in the society. Chief Minister also said that according to DeendayalUpadhyay, the country should be united both in times of war and peace. Only then, along with the development of a developed social system, a well-organized country will be developed. Chief Minister urged the public to read different books written by him to know DeendayalUpadhyay ideology. Chief Minister also expressed his opinion that the current Prime Minister Narendra Modi is running the country by following DeendayalUpadhyay's ideas of running the country based on his Indianness.

Deputy Chief Minister Jishnu Dev varma said, DeendayalUpadhyay's entire life is a vision. Different well-known doctrines of the world have only created divisions among men. But the basic mantra of DeendayalUpadhyay's unity of humanism is the development of every human being in the world. There will be no distinction here. Development will begin with the welfare of the most marginalized person in the society. The present central and state governments are committed to the development of all by believing in that doctrine.

Deputy Chief Minister said that it is in this belief that Prime Minister Narendra Modi, besides providing free vaccination for all the people of this country during the Corona pandemic, also sent Corona vaccine to different countries of the world. This means that India does what it thinks for the welfare of the world. Deputy Chief Minister also said that India should not be considered only by maps, it also has a cultural heritage. Indianness includes cultural nationalism. At the programme, Jail Minister RamPrasad Pal said, PanditDeendayalUpadhyay the pain of felt poverty from his childhood. From that feeling, he sacrificed his life for the welfare of the people and the state. To solve the problems of the society he unitedpeople and formed a mass movement. DeendayalUpadhyay's main aim was to serve the country.

At the programme, Information and Cultural Affairs Minister Sushanta Chowdhury said that the main purpose of celebrating the birthday of real great men is to make the next generation alert and aware about their thoughts. But during the tenure of the previous governments in the state no initiative was purposefully taken to know about India's many great men. But the present Government, through the Department of Information and Cultural Affairs, their birthdays are being celebrated to convey the philosophy of real great men to the people. He also said that history remembers only those who sacrifice themselves for society and country. DeendayalUpadhyay was one such person. He believed in establishing Hinduism in the country but not by hurting any other religion. His doctrine emphasizes solidarity, nationalism, and brotherhood.
