On Farm Demonstration and Input Distribution Programme in Dhalai district

A one-day 'On Farm Demonstration and Input Distribution Programme' was organized by College of Fisheries, CAU (I), Lembucherra at Village Balaram (community hall) under Biotech-Krishi Innovation Science Application Network Project (Biotech-KISAN) yesterday. 33 fish farmers from two selected villages – Marachara and Balaram under Dhalai district have attended the programme. The main objective of the programme was to encourage and boost fish farming and to demonstrate them on various techniques of fish farming. The programme was presided over by the Dean of College of Fisheries Prof. R. K. Saha. Deputy Director of Fisheries department, Dhalai district Tikendrajit Chakma also spoke on the occasion. During the programme, the farmers have interacted with the resource persons regarding fish farming and management practices. Inputs such as fish fingerlings of minor carps, fish feed and lime along with training calendar and handouts were distributed among the farmers.
