**Block level Vikas meeting and camp at Pecharthal**

**Government services are delivered door to door: Labour Minister**

The government has given more importance to the people so that people are not deprived of their rights. Government services and benefits are being delivered door-to-door under Prati Ghare Sushason Campaign. Now people don't have to go to the government offices to get services, rather the government is reaching people's doorsteps. We have started this system in the state. Labour Minister Bhagaban Chandra Das said this while inaugurating the Pecharthal block-level Vikas meeting and camp as part of the Prati Ghare Sushason campaign at Machmara Town Hall yesterday.

In his inaugural address, Labour Minister Bhagaban Chandra Das said that Prati Ghare Sushason campaign is a landmark decision of the government. Through this, the multifaceted public welfare schemes of the central and state governments are being delivered easily to all sections of the people, starting from farmers, laborers, women and youth. He said, among the tribal and rural people, many did not have a proper idea of where to go to get government benefits and services. That is why they had to rely on mediator. He further said that due to the establishment of the new government, free gas connection with furnaces were given free of cost under Ujjawala Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Kishan Samman Nidhi schemes have reached the people. Pecharthal BAC Chairman Sajal Chakma also spoke at the meeting. BDO Sagar Debbarma delivered the welcome address. The guests handed over income certificates, PRTC, wheel chair, hearing aid with tri cycle, gas connection with furnace, new ration card, e-SHRAM card, PM-SYM card, construction workers welfare scheme card, Ujjawala, Joyram and Kishanjoy self-help groups were given loans of two lakhs, one lakh and three lakh respectively, PMEGP and self-reliant loan sanction letters, timber licence, trade licence, cabinet license and a total of 18,500 fish fingerlings were handed over to 9 beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana. A total of 30 stalls were opened in the camp and services were provided through different departments.
