Constitution Day to be observed on November 26

As India is celebrating 75th year of independence as Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav this year, commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of the country tomorrow i.e. November 26 at 11 am. Constitution Day will be observed. On this occasion President Ramnath Kovind will grace the central celebration programme. From the Central Hall of the Parliament President Ramnath Kovind will be administering the reading of the Preamble of the India's Constitution. This programme will be directly telecast from New Delhi on Sansad TV/DD and other channels and online portals. Online reading of the Preamble will be done in 22 official languages and English. Tomorrow in the state also this Preamble reading will be done simultaneously from the state secretariat and different district headquarters. At 11 am tomorrow chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb and other dignitaries will also be taking part in the mass reading of the Preamble of the Constitution. At the same mass reading will take place in different officer of the state government and government undertakings. The government has also urged all the people of the state to take part in this mass reading.
