**Health workers to conduct door to door test  
in AMC areas in next three days: CM**

'Considering the covid positivity rates, the State Government has planned for Antigen tests to be done door to door in AMC areas;' said the Chief Minister after visiting the Covid Care Centre in the Vidyasagar Hostel of Kamalpur H.S Boys School to properly inspect the present COVID-19 scenario. This COVID Care Centre is equipped with 75 beds of which 28 bed are for women. The centre has 2 ventilators and 22 oxygen cylinder equipped beds. The Chief Minister inspected each room of the centre.

After the visit, the Chief Minister informed the media persons that such centre and its services were not there in the previous year in Kamalpur in Dhalai district. Due to the decision of the government to decentralize the health service, it was possible to form this Covid care centre in Kamalpur sub division. The Chief Minister also said that the covid vaccination for the age group of 18-44 years has started today. The government is taking various measures to tackle the present COVID situation. As the health workers will be performing tests door to door in AMC areas in the upcoming three days, the Chief Minister urged everyone to cooperate with them. The Chief Minister also said to the media persons that total three wards of the AMC area have been declared as Containment Zones. Keeping the poor families of the Containment zones in mind, necessary food items and packets will be distributed to them. Besides taking the COVID vaccine, the Chief Minister also urged to follow the COVID behaviour guidelines. Alongwith the Chief Minister, others visiting the Covid Care Centre were Principal Secretary J.K Sinha, DM Govekar Mayur Ratilal, and CMO.
