Commencement of Kharif Abhiyan 2024 in Jubarajnagar Agricultural Division

The Kharif Abhiyan 2024 was launched day before yesterday in a ceremony at the Jubarajnagar Community Hall. The event was inaugurated by Shripad Das, Chairman of the Jubarajnagar Panchayat Samiti. The ceremony was attended by Rajeev Bhowmik, Assistant Director of the Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Department, and Agriculture Supervisor Bijan Sharma, along with other dignitaries. During the event, financial assistance was provided to farmers affected by the Midhili cyclone. A total of 9,94,500 from the State Disaster Response Fund was distributed to the accounts of 812 farmers. The storm had damaged crops over 117 hectares of land in the Sub-Division. The Kharif Abhiyan 2024 program saw participation from the heads of 19 Gram panchayats in the Jubarajnagar block, along with 110 farmer representatives from 20 Gram Panchayats and 3 ADC villages. As part of the campaign, 10 beekeepers from the Madhuban ADC Village, trained by the Agriculture Department, received bee hives and beekeeping boxes, with 40,000 allocated for this initiative. Additionally, three farmers received three power tillers with a subsidy of 1 lakh each.
