Financial Assistance Distributed to Farmers Affected by Midhili in Bishalgarh

In a bid to support farmers affected by the devastating Midhili cyclone, the government has distributed financial assistance amounting 62,87,450. The aid was disbursed directly into the bank accounts of 2,419 farmers from the Bishalgarh sub-division. The distribution event took place day before yesterday at the Gajaria Community Hall of Harishnagar Gram Panchayat. Organized by the local authorities, the program was inaugurated by MLA Antara Dev Sarkar. In her inaugural speech, she emphasized the state government's commitment to agricultural development and the welfare of farmers, highlighting the multi-faceted plans being implemented to support the agricultural sector. The event was presided over by Bishalgarh Panchayat Samiti Chairman Chanda Debbarma. Key figures in attendance included Biswajit Saha, President of the Sepahijala Zilla Parishad Standing Committee on Agriculture, and Sanjib Debbarma, Deputy Director of the Horticulture and Soil Conservation Department. Heads of various Gram Panchayats were also present to show their support. This financial aid, sourced from the State Disaster Response Fund, aims to alleviate the financial burden on the farmers of Bishalgarh, so that they can recover and rebuild their livelihoods post-disaster.
