Government has taken various measures to prevent Covid infection: CM

Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb, to inspect the present COVID-19 scenario visited Sepahijala district today. At first, he visited Lalsinghmura Primary Health Centre and Lalsinghmura Covid Care Centre. Afterwards the Chief Minister visited the Covid Care Call Centre in Bishramganj H.S School, Covid Care Centre in Bishramganj Panchayat Resource Centre and dedicated Covid Care Centre at Melagarh.

During his visit to the Lalsinghmura Covid Care Centre of Bishalgarh sub division, the Chief Minister inspected the health services and asked the concerned health authorities about infrastructural issues of the centre if any. This Covid Care Centre is equipped with 101 beds, including 40 oxygen cylinder equipped beds with 18 patients currently under treatment. Apart from the Chief Minister, Sepahijala Zilla Parishad President Supriya Das Dutta, Zilla Parishad Member Biswajit Saha, Sepahijala DM Biswasree B, Superintendent of Police Krishnendu Chakraborty, CMO Ranjan Biswas, Bishalgarh SDM Jayanta Bhattacharjee, Sub division medical officer Dr. Jyotirmoy Das were present during the visit to Lalsinghmura Covid Care Centre.

Afterwards the Chief Minister inspected the war room and call centre in the Bishramganj H.S Girls School. At present 60 teachers are in charge of the war room and call centre. The Chief Minister said, ' The Government has taken various measures to prevent Covid infection. The Administration is vigilant'. He also said that treatment consultations, ambulance services, admissions in the hospital and information about the availability of bed in the Covid Care Centres of the district through this war room and call centre will be possible and convenient for the public. The Chief Minister urged everyone to strictly follow the Covid health guidelines. After this, the Chief Minister went to inspect the Covid Care Centre in Bishramganj Panchayat Resource Centre equipped with 100 beds attached with oxygen cylinders. During this visit, others present with the Chief Minister were Sepahijala Zilla Parishad President Supriya Das Datta, DM, SP, director of health Dr. Subhasish Debbarma and CMO.

Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb then visited the dedicated Covid Care Centre at Melagarh equipped with 26 oxygen cylinder equipped beds and 4 ventilators. Soon 50 more beds will be added to this Covid Care Centre. Apart from this, 50 beds have been arranged in the Covid Care Centres of Sunamura HS School and in the old building of Melagarh HS School each. The Chief Minister said that top priority is being given to Covid vaccination in the state. He advised to maintain social distance and to follow Covid health guidelines. During his visit, others present with him were MP Pratima Bhowmik, MLA Subhash Das, DM, CMO and other officials. The Chief Minister also inspected the oxygen plant in Sunamura sub-divisional hospital at Melagarh which is under construction.
