1st preparatory meeting for 40th Agartala Book Fair

First Secretary of Bangladesh High Commission S.M Asadujjaman in the meeting said, Bangladesh put up two stalls in the previous book fair. If everything goes well, Bangladesh publishers will be taking part in the upcoming book fair as well. Former Vice Chancellor of Tripura University and Chairman of State Higher Education Council Dr. Arunudoy Saha and President of Agartala Press Club and senior journalist Subal Kumar De spoke about the objective of the book fair.
