**Birendra Nagar ADC Village selected under
Chief Minister's Model Village Scheme**

Birendra Nagar ADC Village has been identified and selected under Chief Minister's Model Village Scheme for the current financial year in Santirbazar Sub-Division for holistic development and to improve the standard of living and quality of life of all sections through improved basic amenities as well as enhanced human development and better livelihood opportunities. In this regard, a review meeting was held in the premises of Birendra Nagar ADC Village on December 14 to discuss on various developmental works being carried out by the line departments. Santirbazar SDM Abhedananda Baidya presided over the meeting with all the stakeholders and officials involved with the scheme in presence of Jolaibari RD Block BAC Chairman Ashok Mo.,

A committee was formed consisting of concerned BDO, line department officials, headmaster of school of the concerned area, women members from SHGs, Village Committee members and NGO working in the area to monitor and evaluate for effective implementation of the works planned under the Chief Minister's Model Village scheme.

Jolaibari RD Block BAC Chairman Ashok Mog urged the officials to actively participate on the Chief Minister's Model Village scheme and meet the targets accordingly.

In the meeting, officials of various line departments highlighted the status of the ongoing developmental work being undertaken at Birendranagar ADC Village and planned projects were also discussed by the officials present in the meeting.

Sub-Divisional Magistrate directed Birendranagar ADC Village officials and representative of line departments to coordinate with various implementing agencies for speedy implementation of the work. The SDM also instructed the block and Panchayat officials to repair one existing hanging bridge of Birendranagar ADC Village and also instructed the officials of Agriculture and Panchayat department to set up one nutrition garden under Birendranagar ADC Village. He said, "One Community Waste Disposal Centre will be set up and every household under Birendranagar will have one garbage pit for disposing of their household waste". He instructed officials of DWS, Power and Jolaibari RD Block to conduct a survey and see if any households, schools, AWC, Health centers are left out without functional toilets, power and water connectivity in the area and take immediate action for the welfare of the people.

The Panchayat officials informed that there are about 550 households with a total population of 2,559 under Birendranagar ADC Village. Panchayat Secretary Upananda Tripura informed the media that there are 10 AWCs, 3 J.B. schools and 1 Senior Basic Schools at Birendra Nagar.

The Chairman, Vice-chairman, representative members of different wards of Birendranagar ADC Village and officials from line departments were also present during the meeting.
