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To enhance quality education significant educational reforms were implemented across the state

In the academic session 2025-26, significant educational reforms were implemented across Tripura to enhance access to quality education, particularly in remote and underserved areas.

A total of 12 Junior Basic (JB) and Senior Basic (SB) schools in Bru resettlement colonies were elevated to Senior Basic (SB) and High Schools, respectively. Additionally, one Senior Basic School in South Tripura District was upgraded to a High School.

Four High Schools in Dhalai, North Tripura, and West Tripura districts were upgraded to Higher Secondary Schools, facilitating students' progression to higher education.

Science streams were introduced in two schools in Sepahijala District, providing students with broader academic choices.

The state continued its initiative to convert Bengali medium schools into English medium institutions. As of this year 5(five) English Medium schools were converted in the current session till date.

These initiatives are part of Tripura's ongoing efforts to align with the National Education Policy (N.E.P.) 2020, aiming to provide equitable and quality education across the state. This information was given through a press release from the department of Secondary Education.
