Meeting Held to Ensure Peaceful Panchayat Elections in Amarpur Block

A crucial meeting was held yesterday in the conference hall of the Amarpur block office to discuss strategies for conducting free and peaceful three-tier Panchayat elections. The meeting, presided over by Block Returning Officer Utpal Das, included the presence of Sub-Divisional Police Officer Debanjali Roy, two Assistant Returning Officers (AROs), sector officers, and representatives of various political parties. During the meeting, Utpal Das provided detailed information about the three-tier Panchayat elections, emphasizing the importance of smooth conduct by all parties involved. The Amarpur block consists of 92 seats spread across 10 Gram panchayats and 9 seats in the Amarpur Panchayat Samiti. To facilitate orderly elections, four sector officers have been appointed across four sectors, and there are 29 polling stations within the block. Additionally, a 10-member committee, chaired by the AROP worker and comprising representatives from various political parties, has been established to address and record grievances from the political parties.
