Dukli block level Lavarthi conference

The present government is working on several schemes for public welfare. It is possible to serve people only if there is sincerity. Reaching the last person through service is Sushason. Deputy Chief Minister Jishnu Dev Varmasaid this while inaugurating Dukli Block-level Lavarthi Conference at Dukli Block Complex yesterday. On the occasion, the Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated 'Deendayal Upadhyay Hatkhola Bazar Shed' at Dukli Block Complex. 20-room Deendayal Upadhyay Hatkhola Bazar Shed has been constructed with the help of Deendayal Upadhyay Rural Empowerment Award money and assistance from the Rural Development Department. 62 lakh rupees have been spent for this construction.

Deputy Chief Minister said that the policy of the present government is Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas. The government is working for people by launching new schemes for public welfare. The aim of the government is to enrich the society and the state. He said that the present government believes in transparent administration. The government is directly disbursing money to the beneficiaries in different schemes through banks. The present government has increased the allowance for different social pension scheme from 700 to 2000 rupees in a short period of time. To strengthen the base of rural economy, presently 38 thousand SHGs have been formed in the state, the number was earlier only 4 thousand.

The Deputy Chief Minister said that the government is determined to provide drinking water connection from house to house under Jal Jeevan Mission. The present government is working to improve education infrastructure by starting English medium schools, launching Vidyajyoti scheme and recruiting quality teachers. He said that the government will move forward on the path of prosperity by taking the people along. Jail Minister Ram Prasad Pal said that the government is organizing Prati Ghare Sushason campaign for the welfare of the people. The Government aim is to provide access to government schemes and services to the last person of the society.

Chairman of Dukli Panchayat Samiti Ajay Kumar Das while delivering the welcome speech said that if an individual is self-reliant, the family becomes prosperous. Dukli Panchayat Samiti is working keeping this idea on forefront. Several programmes have been implemented to improve the socio-economic status of the people and improve the infrastructure of the block. Vice Chairman of Dukli Panchayat Samiti Dulal Chandra Sarkar and others were present at the programme. At the programme, the guests handed over SC and ST certificates to the beneficiaries. Moreover, the keys of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hatkhola Bazar Shed were handed over to 5 beneficiaries.
