

**Tragic Death of Siblings in Chanmari: Chief  
Minister Offers Condolences to Bereaved Family**

On May 18, a tragic accident occurred in the Chanmari area near Agartala city, resulting in the heartbreaking deaths of two children of Krishna Debnath. Eleven-year-old Prasenjit Debnath and seven-year-old Priyanka Debnath fell into a water-filled pit. In response to this sorrowful incident, Chief Minister Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha visited the residence of Krishna Debnath's brother, located near the Jirania School Inspector's Office, to meet with the grieving family members. During his visit, he expressed his deepest condolences and sympathy. The Chief Minister also handed over two cheques, each for ₹4 lakh, amounting to a total of ₹8 lakh, as financial assistance from the State Government's Disaster Management Department.

Later, while addressing reporters, the Chief Minister described the incident as deeply tragic and acknowledged that no words could adequately express his condolences in such a situation. He emphasized that the irreparable loss suffered by this family could never truly be compensated, and no amount of financial aid could make up for their grief.

During the visit, the Chief Minister was accompanied by local MLA and Transport Minister Sushanta Chowdhury, West Tripura DM Dr. Vishal Kumar, Jirania SDM Shanti Ranjan Chakma, and social workers Ranjit Roy Chowdhury and Gouranga Bhowmik, among others.
