

CM inaugurates 100-seated newly built Boy's Hostel in Dasda block

**Overall development must be brought in Kanchanpur also to build self-reliant Tripura:
CM**



125 schools of the state have been brought under Mission Vidyajyoti for quality education. The government has prioritized quality education and expansion of education in tribal populated areas, enunciated Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating 100-seated newly built Boy's Hostel at Barchara High School campus in Dasda block under Kanchanpur sub-division today. Other dignitaries present during the inaugural programme were MLA Prem Kumar Reang, MDC Sailendra Nath, Director of Tribal Welfare department Dr. Bishal Kumar, North Tripura DM & Collector Nagesh Kumar B., SP Dr. Kiran Kumar K., District Welfare Officer Hemanta Debbarma, Kanchanpur SDM Subhash Acharya and Dasda BAC Chairman Jirendra Reang.

The Chief Minister said, the Bru refugee families coming from Mizoram have been living in Kanchanpur for long 23 years. The previous government was reluctant towards solving their problem. But under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Bru refugee families were rehabilitated in different areas of the state. He said, the Prime Minister has started Jal Jeevan Mission to provide clean drinking water to every household of every village of the country. So far, more than 50% families in the state have received clean drinking water connection through pipeline under Jal Jeevan Mission. Efforts have been made to join roads in ADC areas in the state with National Highway. This is a historic step.

The Chief Minister said, overall development must be brought in Kanchanpur also to build self-reliant Tripura. He said, with the efforts of the Prime Minister, houses will be constructed for 2 lakh 28 thousand families under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin. It was due to the efforts of the Prime Minister that free rationing of food items and free Covid-19 vaccination were given during Covid-19 situation.

MLA Prem Kumar Reang said, hostels are being built for tribal students of remote areas of the state. education is the backbone of the society. Development of the society is not possible without education. It is to be noted that the newly built student's hostel was built at the cost of 2 crore 54 lakh 64 thousand 789 rupees. After the inauguration, the Chief Minister visited Ratanmuni Ashram in Anandanagar of Dasda block. in a small programme held there, the Chief Minister said, the state government is working for the overall development of the state under the able guidance of the Prime Minister. But there was a lack in state's overall development in the past days. Rights of the citizens have been ensured through different schemes such as PMAY, Ujjwala Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana, Jal Jeevan and Atal Jaldhara Mission. He said, the present government has made efforts to empower women.
