Target taken up for cultivation of different kinds of crops in West Tripura district

With the initiative of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare department in the present financial year, target has been taken up for cultivation of High Yielding Paddy on 1,355 Ha land, cultivation of Sankar Paddy on 1,530 Ha land, High Yielding SRI Paddy cultivation on 214 Ha, cultivation of Maize on 355 Ha land, cultivation of pulses on 586 Ha land and cultivation of oil seed on 400 Ha land in Jirania agricultural sub-division.

High Yielding Paddy will be cultivated on 585 Ha land, Sankar Paddy will be cultivated on 440 Ha land, High Yielding SRI Paddy cultivation on 30 Ha land, Maize will be cultivated on 175 Ha land, pulses will be cultivated on 281 Ha land and cultivation of oil seed on 170 Ha land will be done in Mandwi agricultural sub-division.

High Yielding Paddy will be cultivated on 670 Ha land, Sankar Paddy will be cultivated on 1,438 Ha land, High Yielding SRI Paddy cultivation on 240 Ha, Maize will be cultivated on 350 Ha land, pulses will be cultivated on 727 Ha land and cultivation of oil seed on 630 Ha land land will be done in Mohanpur agricultural sub-division.

High Yielding Paddy will be cultivated on 200 Ha land, Sankar Paddy will be cultivated on 490 Ha land, High Yielding SRI Paddy cultivation on 20 Ha, Maize will be cultivated on 150 Ha land, pulses will be cultivated on 284 Ha land and cultivation of oil seed on 165 Ha land land will be done in Hezamara agricultural sub-division.

High Yielding Paddy will be cultivated on 980 Ha land, Sankar Paddy will be cultivated on 602 Ha land, High Yielding SRI Paddy cultivation on 96 Ha, Maize will be cultivated on 120 Ha land, pulses will be cultivated on 277 Ha land and cultivation of oil seed on 115 Ha land land will be done in Dukli agricultural sub-division.

Oil seeds have been cultivated on 357 Ha in Jirania, Mandwi, Mohanpur, Hezamara and Dukli agricultural sub-division. Maize has been cultivated on 40 Ha land in Dukli agricultural sub-division and 8 Ha land in Mandwi agricultural sub-division.
