Clarification of Published News

The Daily newspaper "Dainik Sambad" has published on 11.08.2024 under the heading as "শূন্যপদ অর্ধলক্ষাধিক, নেই নিয়োগ রাজ্যে বাড়ছে বেকারের সংখ্যা'' which is not based on facts and therefore clarification are as follows:

In response to the above the Department of Directorate of Employment Service and Manpower Planning clarified that in the news article total number of job-seekers mentioned 5 lakhs which is not true. As per National Career Service Portal as on 31.01.2024 total number active Registered Job- Seekers (un-employed youths) in the NCS Portal is 3,00,029 numbers. Out of that total number of job- seekers upto 9th Passed-49,480 nos, upto 10th-75,790 nos, 12th passed 83084 nos, Diploma after 10-3,125 nos. Diploma after 12th-4200 nos, Graduate-66,932 nos, Post Graduate - 16,526 nos PHD-218 nos, ITI passed-577 nos. PG Diploma-97 nos. It is also mentioned that registration of job-seekers has been going on regularly in all the District Employment Exchanges of the State. Moreover, one new District Employment Exchange has been set up at Belonia on 08.03.2024 for the benefit of unemployed youths of South Tripura District.

It is also mentioned in the news article that recruitment of 2500 nos. MTS through JRBT almost cancelled is totally baseless. Because, JRBT has already completed all the process including written test, interview and the result will be published very soon.

Regarding recruitment in different State Government Departments, it is mentioned that the State Government has already taken adequate steps to resolve the un-employment problems of the State through regular recruitment as well as imparting skill training, implementation of different self- employment schemes etc. Some statistics regarding continuous recruitment in different State Government Departments are indicated below:-

In the year 2022-23 & 2023-24, more than 4849 persons under nonteaching posts were recruited. Apart from this, 5197 persons were engaged through outsourcing and contractual basis. Under Home Department, State Police recruited 119 Nos. Sl and Constable on regular Scale and 1413 TSR, 288 Nos. Group- 'C' & 'D'. 1262 nos. SPO have been recruited during the year 2018-19 to 2023- 24. In the ongoing financial year, 2024-25, Panchayat Department have recruited 395 numbers Panchayat Executive Officer & 43 nos. P.A. Grade-II have been recruited in the GA(P&T) Department through TPSC. Social Welfare & Social Education Department has also recruited 33 nos, CDPO & ICDS Supervisor posts through TPSC in this financial year. Further, 1039 nos. Anganwadi Worker and 1160 nos. Anganwadi Helper have been recruited on the basis of Honorarium Pay during the year 2018-19 to December, 2023. From 2018-19 to till date 6802 teachers have been recruited through TET by the Education Department and 88 persons were recruited as a Special Educator. Through TPSC, 1351 un-employed youth were recruited in different Departments of the State till now and the process is going on to recruit in 745 number posts by the TPSC. 162 nos. Nursing Officer have been recruited in the Health Department.

Proposal is initiated to fill up more than 5870 numbers of vacant posts in various categories by different Departments of the State.

Moreover, the State Government has been implementing various Schemes like Swabalamban, PMEGP, DAYTRLM etc. for unemployed youths of the State to reduce un-employment problems.

To increase the employment opportunities, Job-Fair is being conducted by the Model Career Centres under the Directorate of Employment Services & Manpower Planning. In the last five year, 2018-2019 to 2023-24, 74 Job-Fairs have been conducted and 1241 nos youths have been placed in different Private Sectors.
