



Talking about National Bamboo Mission he said, initiatives have been taken to set up 51 private bamboo industrial unit in the state. 500 necessary toolkits were provided to beneficiaries for making bamboo strips under Mukhyamantri Agarbatti Aatmanirbhar Mission.

The Director of the department further informed, two projects have been taken under SFURTI scheme to make bamboo bottles on cluster level in West Tripura district and to produce Agarbatti in Amarpur.
