Importance being given to quality education in the state. He said, the government is implementing several workplans serially for the overall development of the state. 31, 263 teachers have already gone through the training. 10 schools have been brought under Vidyajyoti scheme in Unakoti district. 135 schools of the state were changed from Bengali to English Medium Schools. 4 Madrasas have been changed to English Medium Schools. Master Degree in Bengali has been expanded to 6 colleges. 4 M.Tech courses have started in TIT. Mother on Campus initiative has started in hostels. Bicycles are being given to girl students of class 9. Work books from class 1 to 12 are being given free of cost to students. The state soon will have a Law University, added Education Minister.

Labour Minister Bhagaban Chandra Das as Chief Guest in the programme said, students are the future of the nation. Education guides the path towards development. New chapter has started in the state in education sector. Sabhadhipati of Unakoti Zila Parishad Amalendu Das, MLA Sudhangshu Das, Unakoti District Magistrate Uttam Kumar Chakma also have delivered their speech in the programme. The programme was presided over by Chairman of School Management Committee Bimal kar. Welcome speech was delivered by District In-charge Education Officer Prasanta Kilikdar. Others present were Saha Sabhadhipati of Unakoti Zila Parishad Shyamal Das, Chairman of Municipal Council Chapla Debroy, Chandipur Panchayat Samiti Chairman Lucky Pal.

Education Minister also inaugurated souvenir and documentary of the school. He then interacted with the students and teachers of the school and visited the newly built building. It was informed that 2 crore 44 lakh 18 thousand 434 rupees was spent to build the new building.
