



milling. Moreover, the state government is providing essential items like rice, sugar, tea, oil etc. to the people through various government ration shops. During Covid-19 situation, the Prime Minister has made arrangements to provide free rice to 80 crore people of the country till March. Tripura is a major agricultural state. In 2017-18, the average monthly income of the farmers was 5 thousand 680 rupees whereas now that has been increased to 11 thousand 93 rupees. Under PMKISAN, 2 lakh 44 thousand farmers are getting 6 thousand rupees annually. Covid-19 vaccine making and vaccination throughout the country was possible with the right guidance of the Prime Minister. He mentioned Health and ASHA workers of the state for playing important role in vaccinating people. Under Mission 100 Vidyajyoti, the state government has taken steps to upgrade 100 schools to CBSE.

MLA Binoy Bhushan Das in the programme lauded the present government for providing rapid services to people and developing Panisagar area. Welcome speech was delivered by North Tripura District Magistrate Nagesh Kumar B. He informed that the Panisagar SDM Office was built through RD department spending 5 crore 63 lakh rupees. Whereas the 50-bedded Sub-Divisional Hospital Building was built through PWD department spending 14 crore rupees. Principal Secretary of Revenue department Puneet Agarwal, SDM Rajat Panth were present in the programme. The programme was presided over by Sabhadhipati of North Tripura Zila Parishad Bhabatosh Das.
