Krishi Gyan Kendra inaugurated in Jolaibari

Krishi Gyan Kendras are being set up in the state to double agricultural produce using scientific and modern processes. Krishi Gyan Kendra is the source from where farmers can gain knowledge from agriculture officials and researchers, enunciated Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister Pranajit Singha Roy after inaugurating a Krishi Gyan Kendra in Jolaibari yesterday.
