

**CM inaugurated new building of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya at Bashpadua, Belonia**  
**Talent is being developed with development of quality education in the state: CM**



The present state government has launched a number of schemes to promote quality education since coming to power. NCERT syllabus has been introduced in the state. Mission Vidyajyoti scheme has been launched. As a result, talent is being developed with development of quality education in the state, enunciated Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating the new building of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya at Bashpadua, Belonia today. He also unveiled a statue of Swami Vivekananda there.

The Chief Minister said, after 36 long years, it has been possible to introduce a new education policy in the country with the initiative of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. This education policy is an income-oriented education policy. One had to go out in search of work only after getting a degree in the previous education policy. The current new education policy has shown a new direction of job creation through vocational education. Emphasis has been placed on technical learning. It was due to Prime Minister Narendra Modi that the new education policy was made possible. He said, recruitment is being done in Tripura through transparent recruitment policy. Recruitment is being done according to merit in transparent way. As a result, even a son of a tea garden worker through TPSC examination could become a TCS officer during the tenure of this government. He said, 33% women reservation has been ensured in government service for empowerment of women. This government is working towards Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas. Food items have been delivered door to door during the pandemic situation. Prime Minister Narendra Modi did not allow the country to fall behind during the Covid-19 situation.

The Chief Minister said, to ensure time appropriate education opportunities as per the national standard indicators, the benefits of Navodaya, Kendriya Vidyalaya and Eklavya Schools are also being successfully implemented in the states. The opportunity to provide time appropriate education has also been expanded in the state through the implementation of national education policy in line with modern education system. Students must have a clear idea of the direction that the country and the state is heading towards. MLA Arun Chandra Bhowmik also spoke on the occasion. Other dignitaries present were Sabhadhipati of South Tripura Zila Parishad Kakali Das Datta, South Tripura Police Official Dr. Kulwant Singh, Headmaster In-charge Tarumoy Nath. Welcome speech was delivered by South Tripura DM Saju Waheed A. The new building school building was built on 25 Acre land at the cost of 41 crore 75 lakh 96 thousand rupees. The school has 240 students studying in it.
