Rules and Regulations

Code of Conduct and Discipline in the Campus

- 1. Every student shall attend classes regularly.
- 2. Students shall always behave with dignity and courtesy.
- 3. Students shall desist from damaging the Institute building, disfiguring the walls, furniture etc. by writing or sticking bills. Such actions are offensive to good taste and are a positive disservice to succeeding generations of students. The cost of the damage, if any, will be recovered.
- 4. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher or until the teacher has left the classroom. Students coming late shall enter the class only with the permission of the teacher
- 5. If somebody wishes to meet a student of a class that is in progress, she/he shall do so only after getting the written permission from the Officer In-charge.
- 6 .No loitering is permitted during class hours
- 7. No meeting or entertainment shall be organized in the institute without the permission of the In-Charge officer.
- 8. Any article lost or found shall promptly be reported to the office.
- 9. Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, habitual shirking of class work and obscenity of any sort are sufficient grounds for the suspension or the dismissal of a student from the institution.
- 10. Students are advised to follow the announcements on the notice boards.

- 5. The submission of leave application does not entitle the student to earn attendance for the days of absence.
- 6. The minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of working is absolutely essential for obtaining Course Certificate
- 7. No application for condonation of shortage of attendance will be recommended by the Registrar unless he is satisfied that the shortage was due to reasons beyond the control of the student and also that leave was availed of during the period of absence.

Student Behavior
