**Virtual inauguration of new building of Sabroom Subdivisional Judicial Court and  
Civil Judge Court**

**Government plans to establish law university in the state: CM**

"Government plans to establish law university in the state and very soon it will be implemented;" said Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb in a video conference after virtually inaugurating the new building of Sabroom Subdivisional Judicial Court and Civil Judge Court (Junior Division) from the Secretariat. Others present in the conference were education and law minister Ratan Lal Nath, MLA Sankar Roy, law secretary Biswajit Palit.

In the inaugural programme, the Chief Minister stressed upon the need for meting out deserved punishments on violence against women and on drug peddling. In this case, he also said that the punishment rate has to be increased in order to give the convicts their deserved punishments and to be vigilant so that the future generation doesn't get hampered because of drug addiction. The Chief Minister in the programme said, the health infrastructure has fairly improved during the Covid second wave as compared to the first wave with proper arrangements for Covid patients in every district of the state consisting of ventilators, oxygen cylinders, oxymeter, oxygen concentrator. The Chief Minister thanked the people of the state for properly following the Corona curfew, Corona night curfew and containment zone rules to control the COVID-19 spread.

Also referring to the industrial infrastructure in Sabroom the Chief Minister said, " These infrastructures will show the people of Tripura a new path." He also hoped that the state will be able to tackle the Black Fungus or Covid pandemic with the cooperation of the public. He urged the public to continue following all the COVID health guidelines and cooperate with the government's adopted rules and regulations.

Tripura High Court Chief Justice Akhil Qureshi from Tripura High Court virtually attended the programme and lauded the design of the new building. He said, " The function of the Law system is not only to judge what is true or false but also to solve the problems of the people and queries within the boundaries of law." Welcome speech was given by South Tripura District and Sessions Judge A. Pandey. Vote of thanks was given by law secretary Biswajit Palit. Apart from them, judges of Tripura High Court, State Advocate General, High Court Registrar General were present in the programme.
