



Chief Minister emphasized making Mukhyamantri Matsya Sakhi more efficient through training which will make them more informative and also help increase fish production. He ordered the department's secretary to take necessary steps to set a target primarily on how many Matsya Sakhi are required and then prepare a list. He also emphasized on marketing of fish and increase cage culture. He asked to take initiative to increase fish cultivation through increase in water bodies in Sabroom. Sabroom has a great opportunity in fish farming. Chief Minister asked the secretary to take initiative in breeding Telapia species of fish. Profit can be earned in very short time. He also emphasized on increasing pisciculture in Dumboor area. Fisheries department secretary Dipa D.
