

Assistance or cultivation of fruit in Bishalgarh subdivision

Horticulture and soil conservation department has provided financial assistance of Rs. 1,21,400 to one beneficiary for cultivation of pineapple in 2 hectare land, Rs 60,700 for plantation of Banana tree in 0.5 hectare land and Rs 60,700 for plantation of Betel nut in one hectare land in Amtali village committee area of Bishalgarh subdivision. On the other hand, Rs 60,700 has been provided to each of total 12 beneficiaries in Bashtali village committee area. Rs 50,000 has been provided to each of two cultivators of Amtali village committee for production of vermi compost. Rs 50,000 has been provided to each of two cultivators for raising Bawar (stage for vegetable). Superintendent of Bishalgarh horticulture and soil conservation office Bimal Das has informed this.

Health camps in Mukhchhari ADC village from Dec 3-17

Health camps will be organized by Tirthamukh PHC in different places of Mukhchhhari ADC village in the month of December. As per the schedule, the health camps will be held in Laxmindar para on Dec 3; Chittapara, Sushen para and Bhuijja para on December 10;

Dakmura reang para on December 17 and Chaplane chhara on December 24. Tirthamukh PHC appealed to the local people to avail the facilities of these health camps.

Special rally on Worlds AIDS Day in Kamalpur

The rally, beginning from Netaji statue ended at the town hall premises after passing through several streets of the town. As part of the rally, under the initiative of Kamalpur NSS unit the students were carrying banners and flags bearing awareness messages on AIDS. The students of 12 schools of the sub-division took part in the rally. Cultivation of scented lemon in 20 hectare

Scented lemon in 20 hectare land and mango orchard in 4 hectare land of Mandwi block have been planted by Mandwi agriculture subdivision office under MGNREGA during the current financial year. Sapling of lemon in 5 hectare land (each village) of Khamtingbari, Harbang, Khengrai and Dincobra villages and sapling of mango in 4 hectare land of Kathirambari village of the block have been planted. 44 families have benefited under the scheme. 6096 mandays have been generated after implementation of the scheme. Rs 12, 49,680 have been spent for this purpose. Mandai agriculture subdivision office has informed this.

Assistance to 87 farmers for orange gardening

Under the initiative of farmers' welfare and agriculture department, financial assistance of 20 thousand rupees will be given to 87 farmers of Jampuijala sub-division in the current fiscal year under MIDH project for orange gardening. This information was given by the Jampuijala agriculture sub-division supervisor Kingshuk Debbarma.

Hybrid rice cultivation in 200 ha. in Tepania block

Initiative has been taken to cultivate hybrid rice in 200 ha land in SRI method in Aman season in Tepania block in the current financial year. Rice has been cultivated recently in 192 ha land. Apart from this, high yielding rice has been cultivated in SRI process in 75 ha land. It has been informed by the Matabari agriculture sub-division office that total 437 farmers of the area have been brought under Mukhya Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in Aman season. Total 1,093 farmers of the area recently have received financial assistance under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi.

Houses for 18 families in Kanchanpur

With the initiative of the Kanchanpur fisheries supervisor office, under Bru Rehabilitation scheme, house construction has been completed for 18 families of Laljuri block in Kanchanpur sub-division in the current fiscal year. Construction work for 2 houses is continued. 5 families of North Laljuri village, 5 families of South Laljuri village, 5 families of Joymoni para village, 5 fishermen families of Chandipur village are benefitting from this. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees has been spent for construction of each house.
