

Over 35,000 farmers brought under PM Kisan in Dhalai

Till now 35,194 farmers have been registered under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi in Dhalai district. Out of the total beneficiaries, 4830 were from Ambassa block, 4452 from Chhamanu block, 5905 from Dumboornagar block, 6035 from Durga Chowmuhani block, 2509 from Ganganagar block, 4482 from Manu block, 3484 from Raishyabari block and 3497 from Salema block. 34,857 Farmers have received their first installment, 34,495 farmers have received second installment of assistance and 32,794 farmers have received third installment. Sandip Some, deputy director of agriculture and farmers welfare department in Dhalai has informed this.

Five administrative camps in Sepahijala in July

District level administrative-cum-health camps will be organized by the Sepahijala district administration in five places of the district in the month of July. One day-long district level administrative-cum-health camp will be held in Batilarma gram panchayat of Bishalgarh block on July 3, in Gulirai ADC Village of Jampuijala block on July 10, in Chechrimai gram panchayat of

Charilam block on July 17, in Anandapur gram panchayat of Mohanbhog block on July 24 and in East Nalchhar gram panchayat of Nalchar block on July 31. District, subdivision and block level administrative officers, doctors and medical staff interacted with the local villagers in the camps regarding administrative and health related matters. The concerned gram panchayats/village committees appealed to the villagers on behalf of the district administration to take advantage of these administrative camps.

Cabinet approves recruitment of 100 Junior Stenographer Personal Assistant Grade –II posts

The state cabinet has approved recruitment proposal of 100 Junior Stenographer Personal Assistant Grade –II posts through the TPSC. The education minister Ratan Lal Nath has informed this in a press meet at the secretariat on June 30, 2020. He informed that there are total 396 vacancies. Recruitment has already been done to 50 posts through the TPSC.

He informed that decision has been taken for recruitment against 100 posts now. The education minister informed that TPSC and

other departments could not conduct competitive examinations for recruitment to different posts due to covid-19 situation. In this situation, age limit of some candidates has expired. Considering this, the cabinet has approved one year relaxation in age limit of the candidates. But this age relaxation has been granted for only one year. In this case, candidates who will apply for the posts before December 31, 2020 only they will be considered for this facility.

**49,133 Mandays generated in
Gournagar block**

Under MGNREGA various development activities have been implemented in gram panchayats and ADC villages under Gournagar block. Under the scheme during the current financial year till now 49,133 mandays have been generated. In this process construction of dams for irrigation, earth leveling, digging of water bodies etc. works have been accomplished. An amount of Rs. 78.25 lakh has been spent for all these activities. The Gournagar block office source has informed this.

**Drinking water connections for 544
families of Panisagar**

Drinking water connections have been provided by DWS department to 544

families of Panisagar, Damchhara blocks and Panisagar Nagar panchayat during the current financial year. Under the scheme, 279 families of Panisagar block , 250 families of Damchhara block and 15 families of Panisagar Nagar panchayat have availed drinking water connections.

The executive engineer of DWS department Animesh Das has informed that 1416 families of Panisagar block, 751 families of Damchhara block and 466 families of Panisagar Nagar panchayat have availed drinking water connection free of cost under the scheme during the 2019-20financial year.

**70 Families under NFBS
in Khowai district**

Under the aegis of Khowai district social welfare and social education department office a total of 70 families have been brought under National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS).
