

Water connection under Atal Jaldhara in rural areas

Free water connection under Atal Jaldhara Mission is being given to every rural household of the state. From June 1 to 30, 2021 total 8,581 houses got drinking water connection. 637 houses in North district, 513 in Unakoti district, 800 in Dhalai district, 878 in Khowai, 1506 in West district, 1670 in Sepahijala district, 1657 in Gomati district and 920 houses in South district were given free water connection. This was informed in a press release issued by the drinking water and sanitation department.

70,000 Mandays generated in Rupaichhari this year

During the current financial year till date 70,000 mandays have been generated in Rupaichhari block under MGNREGA. Under the initiative of various departments various development activities have been accomplished in 28 ADC villages. The activities included CC road construction, renovation of road, upgradation of Anganwadi centre and renovation as well, digging pond and reclamation of pond, land leveling, construction of irrigation canal and check dam, raising rubber plantation etc. Through these activities a total of 5,720

people have benefited, informed the Rupaichhari block office source.

Road construction in Boxanagar

Five roads are being constructed in Boxanagar block area with the initiative of rural development department spending 48 lakh 277 rupees. Brick roads are being constructed in Motinagar, Kulibari, Dhanirampur Panchayat, Boxanagar Gram Panchayat, Anandpur Gram Panchayat of Boxanagar block spending 6 lakh 85 thousand 844 rupees, 12 lakh 33 thousand 538 rupees, 10 lakh 3 thousand 376 rupees, 10 lakh 53 thousand 966 rupees, 8 lakh 23 thousand 553 rupees respectively. This was informed by the executive engineer, RD department's Sepahijala district office.

Advance social pension to beneficiaries in Dhalai

39 Thousand 542 beneficiaries are getting various central and state government social pensions under six projects in Dhalai district with the initiative of social welfare and social education department as informed by Uttam Kumar, deputy director of the department, Dhalai district. He said the beneficiaries were given pensions for the month of May,

June and July together in advance from both central and state governmental schemes into their accounts in June. 6 thousand 347 beneficiaries from Ambassa project, 16 thousand 747 from Salema project, 1 thousand 52 from Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat area, 7 thousand 70 from Manu project, 4 thousand 498 from Dumburnagar project and 3 thousand 828 beneficiaries from Chawmanu project were benefitted.

Chief Minister Special Relief Package implemented in South district

"76 thousand 222 families in South Tripura district are being distributed food items under Chief Minister COVID Special Relief Package. 1 thousand rupees is also being transferred into bank accounts of 74 thousand 802 families of the district," enunciated South Tripura DM & Collector Saju Waheed in a press meet held on June 29. He also said that food packets are being distributed to beneficiaries at 233 ration shops in the district. The distribution process will continue in Mission mode till July 2.

The DM informed that initiative has been taken to vaccinate 3 lakh 18 thousand 980 persons in the district. Among them 2 lakh

64 thousand 257 persons have taken their 1st Covid vaccine shots and 85 thousand 572 persons have taken 2nd shot. He announced that 100% vaccination has been accomplished in 21 Gram Panchayats of the district.

Chief Minister Special Relief Package implemented in Gomati district

"Assistance is being provided in Gomati district to 86 thousand 678 families under Chief Minister COVID Special Relief Package. Among them 52 thousand 885 families from Udaipur sub division, 20 thousand 7 from Amarpur sub division, 13 thousand 786 from Karbook sub division will be given assistance," enunciated Gomati ADM Arun Kumar Roy in a press conference held on June 29 at the DM office's conference hall. He said that so far 42 thousand 204 families were given food packages in the district.

The ADM in the press conference also said, " 32 thousand 66 families from Udaipur sub division, 7 thousand 773 from Amarpur sub division and 2 thousand 365 from Karbook sub division have received food packages in the district. 1 thousand 500 rupees has been sent to Covid patients in home isolation in the district. In the press conference district CHO Nirumohan Jamatia informed that so far 79,186 persons of 18-44 age group,

70,466 persons of 45-59 age group and 31,316 persons of 60 years and above have been vaccinated.

Under PM Kisan 6,319 farmers enlisted in Dumboornagar block

Under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi 6,319 farmers of Dumboornagar block in Dhalai district have been enlisted. Under the scheme each farmer is entitled to Rs. 6000 financial assistance to be given in three installments. Detailing further Soumen Nandi, deputy director of agriculture and farmers' welfare department in Dhalai office said, under the scheme from the beginning 6,140 farmers have received first installment totaling Rs. 1,22,80,000. Similarly, 6,167 farmers have received the second installment and 5,999 farmers have received third installment of assistance. With this, Rs. 1,23,34,000 and Rs. 1,19,98,000 have been transferred in the second and third installment respectively.

Road construction in Sonamura

Four roads are being constructed under PWD, Sonamura division. These are - the road from Srimantapur Checkpost zero point to custom station, roads of different areas of Sonamura Nagar Panchayat,

construction of various pucca drain in Sonamura Nagar Panchayat area and various brick road construction etc. Total expenditure has been calculated at Rs. 67.29 lakh. Apart from that, a gate at Srimantapur international port and 50 bedded residential hostel for SC students of Sonamura Girls School is being constructed. Total expenditure is estimated to be 3 crore 14 lakh 26 thousand rupees. Apart from this, repairing work of PWD office, Sonamura division, is in progress spending 4 lakh 65 thousand rupees. This was informed by PWD department, Sonamura division.

Fruit & vegetable saplings distribution under MSPY in Tulashikhar block

Tulashikhar agri-subdivision office has set a target to distribute saplings of fruits and vegetables among 4,094 families of 23 ADC villages of Tulashikhar block under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. So far distribution has been completed for 3,710 families. Each beneficiary is getting 3 areca nut saplings, 2 banana saplings, 4 lemon saplings, 6 papaya saplings and mini seed kits of bean, okra, radish etc. For this, Rs. 11,29,944 will be spent. This has been informed by the Tulashikhar agri-subdivision office.
