Crime against women declining: CM

At present the state is experiencing a downward crime graph. Number of crimes against women has declined in the state according to NCRB report, stated chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after



inaugurating the newly built building of Amarpur sub-divisional court yesterday. The new building was built investing total Rs. 694.00 lakh. The chief minister said, how safe and secure a region is, is one of the indicators of a healthy society. Reducing crime rate against women in the

state is not enough. That number will have to be reduced to zero with joint efforts. Judges including the Chief Justice of the High Court have played a significant role in providing justice to the people of the state.

Chief minister also said, apart from taking positive steps to control crimes in the state, various schemes are being implemented for the welfare of all sections of the people. Covid vaccine is yet to be ready for children under 18. Mukhyamantri Sustho Shoishob Sustho Koishor project is playing a very important role in building immunity in children of this age group and protecting them from various diseases. Besides that, government is working on priority basis for the development, publicity and expansion of state's tourism sector. Various plans are being implemented to attract large number of tourists towards the state which will help prosper the state economically. He urged everyone to give importance to the comfort of tourists with 'Athithi Devo Bhava' mentality. Chief Minister said, rise in number of tourists will help boost the state economy for which everyone's joint effort and

hospitality is required. The government will positively consider the renovation of various court buildings and staff quarters in the state and the development of infrastructure.

Chief Justice of Tripura High Court A Qureshi in the programme said, the role of the court is like the pressure bulb in a pressure cooker. Either party stays frustrated by the judicial system or the ruling in a case. People's confidence in the judiciary must be maintained by ensuring human rights in the right way. Court building is a part of the judiciary. He hoped that this new court building will play a special role in solving the small and big problems of the people as an ideal temple of justice. Besides, he drew the Chief Minister's attention to renovation of various courts and staff quarters in the state, development of infrastructure and increase in budget allocation.

Others present in the programme were Justice of Tripura High Court Subhasish Talapatra, Justice Arindam Lodh, Justice Satyagopal Chatterjee, lawyer B. Palit, Tripura High Court registrar general Datta Mohan Jamatia, and state advocate general Siddharth Sankar Dey.

Coconut seedlings distributed among farmers at Baikhora

Two hundred twenty seedlings have been distributed among 22 beneficiaries through a programme at Baikhora agriculture sector office under Charakbai Gram Panchayat in Santirbazar sub-division by the agriculture and farmers' welfare department on September 30. Ten seedlings have been given to each farmer. Till now around 5,045 coconut seedlings have been distributed and five beneficiaries have received 50 coconut seedlings in every Gram Panchayat.
