# MGNREGA in Killa block: 1,70,630 mandays generated

Various works are being implemented in 16 ADC villages of Killa block under MGNREGA. Under the scheme 1,70,630 mandays have been generated till July of the current financial year. Through these activities 7,541 families have benefitted. Renovation of road, land leveling, digging of pond, orchard plantation, afforestation etc. activities were done under the scheme. Total Rs. 5,90,08,000 has been spent in these works.

#### **RKVY: 12 Fish farmers benefitted**

# Assistance to 9,107 families of Longtrai Valley under CMSPY

9,107 Families of Longtrai Valley sub division will be benefited under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in the present financial vear from horticulture and soil conservation department. Among them, 6 thousand 325 families from Labanchara, Daluchara, Deo RF, Longtraiphai RF, Chichingchara, Kadhalchara, Battala, Jamichara, Demchara, East Karamchara and Kanchanchara villages of Manu block will be given mini packets of different kinds of vegetable seeds worth Rs. 50.

Apart from this, each family will be given 5 banana tree saplings, 6 papaya tree saplings and 4 lemon tree saplings. Therefore 6 thousand 325 families will be given 31 thousand 625 banana tree saplings, 37 thousand 950 papaya tree saplings and 25 thousand 300 lemon tree saplings. 2 thousand 782 families from Debachara, Rajdhar, East Malidhar, East Chawmanu and Durgabari villages of Chawmanu block will be given mini packets of different kinds of vegetable seeds worth 50 rupees each. Each family will be given 5 banana tree saplings, 6 papaya tree saplings and 4 lemon tree saplings. Therefore, 2 thousand 782 families of this block will be given total 13 thousand 910 banana tree saplings, 16 thousand 692 papaya tree saplings and 11 thousand 128 lemon tree saplings. This was informed by Alok Kumar Das, deputy director, horticulture and soil conservation department office, Dhalai district.

### 477 persons of Belonia municipal area benefited under PMMVY
