

LPG connection provided to 34,172 families of Sepahijala

LPG connections have been provided to 34,172 families of Sepahijala district under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. Among them, 14,242 BPL families of Sonamura subdivision, 9,375 BPL families of Bishalgarh subdivision and 6,824 BPL families of Jampuijala subdivision have availed LPG connection as per information provided by the Bishalgarh subdivision food and civil supplies office. Gas cylinder and oven have been provided to the women of the mentioned families free of cost.

Achievement of Sepahijala district under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana

Almost 1, 32,868 beneficiaries of South Tripura district have availed E-card under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana up to October 30, 2020. This number is almost 67 percent of the total beneficiaries of the district (1, 99,937 persons as per survey). 4271 beneficiaries have already availed medical service under the scheme. At present 13 hospitals in Sepahijala district are under the scheme. Almost 5 lakh families of the state have been registered under Pradhan Mantri

Jana Arogya Yojana. Some initiatives have been taken for providing this facility to eligible members under the scheme. Such as, door to door E-card registering, miking, campaign through distribution of leaflet and documents collected by ASHA workers etc.

Recently publicity through a LED van on behalf of Tripura Health Suraksha Samiti has been started for introducing benefit of the scheme. The van was launched from Bishalgarh Subdivision hospital for publicity purpose on November, 25. SDMO of Bishalgarh subdivision Dr. J.M Das was present in the programme. These leaflets were distributed through the van among the people in market areas of 97 gram panchayats. State Agency of the scheme has informed this in a statement.

3,34,073 man-days generated under MGNREGA in Mohanpur

Various developmental works are being implemented under MGNREGA in Mohanpur block. So far 3 lakh 34 thousand 73 man-days have been generated in the current fiscal year under this spending 6 Cr 48 lakh 95 thousand rupees. Ponds were excavated and repaired, drainage were repaired, roads were constructed and repaired, orchards were cleaned and various works including

water source making were done in the block area under this benefitting 12 thousand 302 families. Average man-days generated were 27.2. Initiative has been taken to build toilets for 323 families under Swachh Bharat Mission (rural) in Mohanpur block in the current fiscal year. So far 233 toilets were built spending Rs. 12,000 for building each toilet. This information was collected from Mohanpur block office.

E-card provided to 1, 86,866 people under Ayushman Bharat in South district

Almost 1, 86,866 beneficiaries of South Tripura district have availed E-card under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana upto October 30, 2020. This number is 95 percent of the total number of beneficiaries in south Tripura district (1, 95,031 persons as per survey). At present 15 hospitals in South Tripura district are under the scheme. Almost 5 lakh families of the state have been registered under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana.

Some initiatives had been taken to ensure better coverage by providing certain facilities to the eligible people under the scheme, such as, door to door registering, miking, campaign through distribution of

leaflet and issuing E-card through collection of documents by ASHA workers. Recently publicity through a LED van on behalf of Tripura Health Suraksha Samiti has been started for briefing about the benefits of the scheme. The van was launched from Belonia Subdivisional hospital for publicity purpose on November 10. The van was inaugurated by CMO of South Tripura district Dr. Jagadish Nama. Leaflets were distributed through this van among the people in market areas of 65 gram panchayats.

Rs.17,94,13,698 crore collected under small savings in Gomati

17 Cr 94 lakh 13 thousand 698 rupees has been collected till the month of October in the current fiscal year under small savings scheme in Gomati district. Small savings development scheme officer, Gomati district informed that 15 Cr 43 lakh 78 thousand in Udaipur sub-division, 2 Cr 41 lakh 79 thousand 406 rupees in Amarapur sub-division, 8 lakh 56 thousand 292 rupees in Karbook sub-division was collected. It has also been informed that the target is to collect 28 Cr rupees in the current fiscal year under small savings scheme in Gomati district.
