

Assistance for pisciculture in Bharatchandranagar block under CMSPY

Assistance has been provided for fish farming to 876 beneficiary families in Bharatchandranagar block under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in the previous financial year. Each beneficiary family was provided with 500 mixed fish fingerlings. Apart from that, these beneficiary families were also given training on advanced method of fish farming. In the present financial year, assistance will be provided to 980 families of the block under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. This was informed by Fisheries department, Rajnagar office.

3,800 farmers brought under PMFBY in Rupaichari block

In the previous financial year, 3 thousand 800 farmers in Rupaichari block of Sabroom sub-division have been brought under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana. 9,39,580 mandays generated in Gouranagar block under MGNREGA

9 lakh 39 thousand 580 mandays were generated in Gouranagar block of Unakoti district under MGNREGA in the previous financial year. In average 97.72 mandays were generated in the block. 15 crore 73 lakh 54 thousand rupees was spent for this. 12 thousand 882 families of the block were benefited. So far, 1 lakh 23 thousand 312 mandays were generated in the last two months in Gouranagar block in the present financial year. So far, 5 thousand 634 families have found work opportunities. 2 crore 53 lakh 55 thousand rupees was spent for this. It was informed by Gouranagar Block BDO Rameshwar Chakraborty.

Social pension to 6,777 persons in Kathalia block

6 thousand 777 persons of Kathalia block are getting social pensions under different schemes of the central and the state government. Among them, 2 thousand 82 persons are getting social pension from the central government and 4 thousand 695 persons are getting social pension under different state government schemes. Apart from that, 2 thousand 543

women of the block are getting financial assistance of 5 thousand rupees under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana. This was informed by Kathalia ICDS office.

Social pension to 10,061 persons in Satchand block

10 thousand 61 persons are being provided with social pensions under different schemes in Satchand block. Among them, 3 thousand 317 persons are getting pension under Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme, 59 persons are getting pension under Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme, 652 persons are getting pension under Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension Scheme and 10 persons are getting pension under a scheme for 100% Blind persons. e-Shram cards to 33,568 workers in Sabroom sub-division

Total 33 thousand 568 unorganized workers have been registered in Sabroom sub-division and e-Sham cards have been distributed to them. Among them, 9

thousand 316 workers in Rupaichari block, 3 thousand 997 workers in Poangbari block, 18 thousand 404 workers in Satchand block and 1 thousand 851 workers in Sabroom Nagar Panchayat have been registered. This was informed by Labour department, Sabroom sub-division office.

Pucca houses to 2,896 beneficiaries of Bharatchandranagar block under PMAY-G

Construction of houses for 2 thousand 896 beneficiaries in Bharatchandranagar block has started in the previous financial year under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin. Among the beneficiaries, 392 beneficiaries are from East Kalabaria Panchayat. 2 thousand 896 beneficiaries have already received their first installment for construction of the house. 1,817 beneficiaries have got their second installment and 63 beneficiaries have got their third installment.

Apart from that Chittamara 2no. Anganwadi Centre of Chittamara Panchayat in Bharatchandranagar block is also being constructed at the cost of 8 lakh 83 thousand 491 rupees, out of which 4 lakh 33 thousand 491 rupees is of

MGNREGA and 4 lakh 50 thousand rupees is of Social Welfare & Social Education department. Besides, the construction of new Pucca house of Bhumihin Colony Anganwadi Centre of Ishanchandranagar Panchayat is progressing at the cost of 8 lakh 83 491 rupees. This was informed by Bharatchandranagar Block Office.

Free spectacles distributed in Nirbhaypur UPHC under MMMDP
