

## Chief Minister inaugurates PHC and other office buildings in Khowai

“Present government is a pro-people government and believes in bringing about development. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has fulfilled his promise to turn Tripura into HIRA model in just two and half years,” stated the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating the new building SP office in Khowai and DM & Collector yesterday, where he was paid guard of honour by the police force. Later he planted a sapling at the campus of SP office. Chief minister also inaugurated the



newly built 10-bedded building of Baijalbari Primary Health Centre in Khowai district. Later he handed Ayushman Bharat e-card to three beneficiaries. Construction of The new building of Khowai DM & Collector office and SP office incurred an expenditure of about

Rs. 2 crore and another Rs. 2 crore for Baijalbari Primary Health Centre.

Speaking on the occasion the chief minister said, “Tripura is leading in Covid vaccination drive across the country. He lauded the dedication of health workers who are reaching out to remote areas of the state to ensure 100% Covid vaccination”. He also said that the young people of the state are moving ahead through Start-Ups. The central government has given special discount to Tripura in regard to housing under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Tripura is going to have 1 lakh 80 thousand houses built under this scheme investing total Rs. 2,000 crore. All the materials will be procured from Tripura only; as a result, the revenue will remain in the state itself. The people of the state are reaping benefits starting from water, electricity, connectivity etc. due to PM Modiji’s schemes.

Addressing the gathering the forest and tribal welfare minister Mewar Kumar claimed that this double engine government is working continuedly for the overall development of the state even in the challenging times of pandemic. This government has set up several Eklavya schools and took necessary steps for the welfare of SC, ST and minority students.

### **Water irrigation source in Charilam block**

Roads in different panchayats of Charilam block and Pucca drainage system for irrigation are being constructed with the initiative of rural development department investing Rs. 70,66,479. Construction of a box culvert is also under progress in Rangmala village of the block investing Rs.11,23,095. A Pucca road is being built in North Brajpur Gram Panchayat investing Rs. 29,33,158. A brick soling road was extended in Madhya Brajpur Gram Panchayat spending Rs. 5,60,256. Apart from this, Pucca drainage system has been but for irrigation in Bishramganj Gram Panchayat investing Rs. 6,19,710. This was informed by the

executive engineer's office, rural development department.

### **Water connection in Lefunga block**

Work is under progress to provide free water connection to every household in the state by December 2022 under Atal Jaldhara Mission. So far 212 households have been given water connection in 10 ADC villages of Lefunga block under Mohanpur sub division in the current financial year. Apart from this 2 thousand 3 families of the block were given free water connection under this scheme. This was informed by Drinking Water and Sanitation sub division office.

### **Ayushman Bharat e-card distribution in Fatikroy**

In a special campaign from August 2 to 4, Ayushman Bharat e-card is being distributed at Fatikroy Primary Health Centre under Saidapar and Rajkandi Gram Panchayat of Unakoti district. 1,000 beneficiaries will be given Ayushman Bharat e-cards in the campaign. Other services like linking new beneficiary's Aadhaar card is being done. Names of family members are also being added. Awareness campaign is also being done regarding various services of Ayushman Bharat.
