

## **Administrative-cum-health camp in Bijohnagar village**

Under the initiative of Sepahijala district administration and Sonamura sub-divisional administration an administrative-cum-health camp was held at Bijohnagar ADC village office under Boxanagar block yesterday. During the camp, DM Vishwasree B and Sonamura SDM Subrata Majumder reviewed the development activities with the officials of various departments. In the camp 26 applications for ST certificate, four applications for marriage registration certificate and 35 applications for PRTS were submitted. On the part of the health department 25 persons were COVID vaccinated and 47 persons, post examination, were given free medicines. The ARD department also provided medicines to 222 domestic animals of 42 families.

## **CM inaugurates 132 KV transmission line and Ganganagar PHC building**

"The government is paying great importance to the overall development of the state. The people have waited 13 years for Ambassa-Ganganagar transmission line to be started, whereas right after the present government took over the transmission line has been

inaugurated today that too within just three years", state the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating the Ganganagar new PHC building and Ambassa-Ganganagar 132KV Transmission line yesterday.

Before the commencement of the programme, the chief minister inaugurated 10 bedded Ganganagar new PHC building and Ambassa-Ganganagar 132kv Transmission line. The chief minister was accompanied by the deputy chief minister Jishnu Dev Varma, MP Rebati Tripura, MLA Dhananjay Tripura, MDC TTAADC Bhumikananda Reang, power department's secretary Kiran Gitte, TSECL Managing Director M.S Kele, family welfare, and preventive medicine director Dr. Radha Debbarma and SDM Mayur Gowekar Ratilal.

The chief minister said, the government on priority basis is working to bring in development in the field of water, electricity, health, education and communication to areas like Ganganagar, Raishabari as the overall development of the state is impossible leaving even one area behind. The government is also paying attention to decentralization of health services. Four thousand families will be able to get health services from the PHC.

The chief minister said, Ganganagar is now not only having PHC and transmission line but also DPR of the road is being prepared. Banks, fire stations and several other services will be modernised in this area. Work is in progress to develop 12 Aspirational blocks under the present government. Water connection is being provided to every household through Atal Jaldhara Mission and Jal Jeevan Mission.

Deputy chief minister Jishnu Dev Varma in the programme said, "the previous state government even after increasing 90% electricity tariffs could not bring development to the services whereas the present government is setting up example on how to improve electricity services without extra tariffs hikes. Instead, the state government has managed funds from different organisations and has started this project. By December, the transmission line will extend to Gandacherra. Apart from this, target has been taken to set up more 34 electricity sub stations. Emphasis is being put on modernisation of the electricity corporation." The Chief Minister later interacted with indigenous people and wanted to know if they were being provided benefits under Chief Minister Covid Special Relief Package.

### **Certified Aman seeds procured from farmers of Gournagar agri-subdivision**

Under the initiative of Gournagar agri-subdivision office 103 MT Aman seeds have been purchased from the registered farmers under Seed Certification Scheme during the 2020-21 financial year. Per kg Aman seed has been procured at the rate of Rs. 24. It is noteworthy that under the supervision of the agriculture and farmers' welfare department these seeds, after cultivation, are purchased by the department itself from the farmers. The same seeds are later on distributed by the department among the farmers. During the 2020-21 financial year the break-up of Aman seeds procured was like this – 53 MT from Samrurpar, 40 MT from Jalai, and 10 MT MTU 7029 variety from Sonaimuri. Additionally, 2 MT of Swarnasar – 1 variety has been procured from Samurupar. Gournagar agri-subdivision office has divulged this information.

### **Over 5.63 lakh mandays generated in two blocks of Dhalai**

During the current financial year 5,63,756 mandays have been generated under MGNREGA in Durga Chowmuhani and

Salema block of Dhalai district. An amount of Rs. 11,95,16,272 has been spent for this purpose. Under the scheme, 3,49,109 mandays have been generated in Durga Chowmuhani and 2,14,647 mandays have been generated in Salema block spending Rs. 7,40,11,108 and Rs. 5,55,5,164 respectively. This information has been given by the Dhalai DM office source.

### **Kamalpur fisheries office's massive initiative for fish farmers**

Towards socio-economic development of the fish farmers of Kamalpur subdivision several projects are being implemented by the subdivision's fisheries supervisor's office during the 2021-22 financial year. Kamalpur subdivision's fisheries supervisor Dr. Apu Das informed, under the Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana 541 of Salema block and 830 of Durga Chowmuhani block will be assisted with fish fingerlings. In addition, the fisheries department, through its own scheme, will provide Magur fingerlings to eight beneficiaries, Shing fish fingerlings to eight beneficiaries, lobster spawns to 40 beneficiaries, and fish seeds to 46 beneficiaries. Additionally, fish fingerlings will be given for 9 ha. water body of self-help groups.

On the other hand, 208 fish farmers of the subdivision will be given fish feed and fingerlings at subsidized rate and 124 beneficiaries will be given fishing net. Besides, in order to assist the fish farmers financially the department will facilitate loan through Kishan Credit Card. Further, initiative has been taken to impart training on scientific fish farming to 300 fish farmers and fishing net to 200 beneficiaries of two blocks.

### **Fingerlings distributed in Panisagar under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana**

Fish fingerlings were distributed among fish farmers of Panisagar block under the Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana through a special programme held yesterday at Fishery Knowledge Centre in Panisagar. MLA Bidhubhushan Das inaugurated the distribution programme in presence of Panisagar Panchayat Samiti's chairman Sanjoy Das, Panisagar CDPO Homagni Bhattacharya and Panisagar fisheries supervisor Animesh Chakma. On the occasion 25 fish farmers were given 500 fingerlings each and a daylong training on fish farming was also organized for them. The training was conducted by fisheries supervisor Animesh Chakma fisheries officer Sampa Paul and other officials.
