

My Tehsil Citizen Service in Lefunga block

A mega revenue and My Tehsil Citizen Service camp was organized in Lefunga block with the initiative of Mohanpur sub divisional administration at Satya Roy High School Bir Mohan ADC village. In the camp 97 birth certificates, 1 death certificate, 120 marriage certificates, 180 ST certificates, 175 PRTC were provided and names for ration card, Aadhar card, voter ID card etc were registered. 22 property related applications were also submitted. Mohanpur SDM Subhash Duta, ADM Takhirai Debbarma, Lefunga block BDO Mahendra Kambe were present in the programme.

7,853 benefited under PMKSNY in Ambassa & Ganganagar block

Till date 7,853 farmers of Ambassa and Ganganagar block of Dhalai district were brought under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana. Each farmer is getting Rs 6 thousand in three installments. This was informed by Soumen Nandi, deputy director, district agriculture & farmer's welfare department office. 5,291 Farmers from Ambassa block and 2,562 farmers from Ganganagar block have benefited under the scheme.

Social Pension to 2,019 beneficiaries of Poangbari block

2,019 Beneficiaries of Poangbari block under Sabroom sub division are getting different social pensions. Among them, 1,485 beneficiaries are from seven Gram Panchayats, 534 beneficiaries are from three villages. This information was collected from Satchand SDPO office.

11,287 Gas connections in Sabroom under Ujjwala Yojana

Till date 11,287 families have received cooking gas connection under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana in Sabroom sub division through three gas agencies in the sub division. This information was collected from Sabroom SDM office.

5,685 Farmers in Nalchar block under Fasal Bima Yojana

5 thousand 6 hundred 85 farmers of Nalchar block of Sonamura sub divisional are being brought under Fasal Bima Yojana with the initiative of agriculture and farmer's welfare department. Among them 4 thousand 530 farmers are under Mukhyamantri Fasal Bima Yojana and 1 thousand 155 farmers are under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana. This

Assistance to 2,169 families for pisciculture in Mohanpur

2,169 families were given assistance in the current financial year under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana from fisheries department for pisciculture. Among them, 207 families are from Lefunga block, 804 families from Mohanpur block, 692 families Bamutia block, and 466 families from Hezamara block. Each beneficiary family was given 500 fish fingerlings. This information was collected from Mohanpur fisheries superintendent office.

Water connection to 7,103 Families in Dumburnagar & Raishyabari block

Drinking Water & Sanitation department has taken initiative to give drinking water connection to 7 thousand 103 families of Dumburnagar & Raishyabari block in the current financial year under Atal Jaldhara Mission. Already 182 families have got water connection. Under this scheme, 4 thousand 41 families of Dumburnagar are to get water connection. Among them 44 families already got water connection. 3 thousand 62 families are to get water

connection. Apart from this, in financial year 2020-21, 2 thousand 799 families of Dumburnagar block were given drinking water connection and 572 families of Raishyabari. This information was collected from DWS Executive Engineer Hiranmoy Chakma.

73 Ponds under PM Matsya Sampada Yojana

Under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampad Yojana in the current financial year, 73 ponds will be excavated in Sepahijala district for expansion of fish cultivation, which will benefit 73 fish farmer families. 60% subsidy to ST, SC fish farmers and 40% subsidy to other fish farmers will be given for pond excavation. 1 lakh 34 thousand 400 rupees will be invested in excavating each pond.

Out of 73 ponds, 28 ponds will be dug in Jampuijala district, 5 in Charilam block, 5 in Bishalgarh block, 9 in Mohanbhog block, 10 in Nalchar block, 9 in Boxanagar block and 7 ponds in Kathalia block. Apart from this, Biofloc tank for six beneficiaries will be made investing Rs. 2.14 lakh for each tank. Total Rs. 12.84 lakh will be invested.
