

New building of Sringeri Sarada Vidyamandir inaugurated

The newly built building of Sringeri Sarada Vidyamandir has been recently inaugurated by the former Principal of Ram Krishna College Amrit Kumar Bhattacharya at Pechardahar of Chandipur block under Kailasahar sub-division. Sahakari Sabhadhipati of Unakoti Zilla Parishad Shyamal Das, as the chief guest of the programme said, students will greatly benefit once classes start in this new building. The programme was presided over by Bilaspur Gram Panchayat Pradhan Ratan Sarkar. Welcome speech was delivered by the member of School Management Committee Swapan Bhattacharya. Other dignitaries present in the programme were district education officer Prasanta Kilikdar and former Pradhan of Bilaspur Gram Panchayat Krishna Kumar Sinha.

6 Box Culverts constructed in Amarpur block

Construction of six box culverts in different rural areas of Amarpur block is under progress under MGNREGA. The project is being implemented by the Amarpur Division of rural development department. Total expenditure in the

project implementation will be 1 crore 29 lakh 94 thousand 101 rupees. Apart from this, to improve connectivity in rural areas, a brick soling road is being constructed from Lepra Para to Nanu Chandra Para of Bhomrachara village. Total expenditure for this will be 37 lakh 17 thousand 789 rupees. Also, a brick soling road is being constructed from PWD Road to Asha Chandra Para JB School of East Sarbang village. To prevent soil erosion, a RCC wall will be constructed in Khedarnal village at the cost of 22 lakh 14 thousand 622 rupees. Apart from this, RCC Check Dam is also being constructed in Gathiram Para of Malbassa village. Total expenditure for this will be 22 lakh 32 thousand 243 rupees. This was informed by Amarpur Block Office.

Developmental works in Birganj Panchayat under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana

In the financial year 2021-22, different development works are being implemented in Birganj Panchayat under Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana. 3 kms of pipeline is being extended at the cost of 3 lakh rupees through LI scheme with the

initiative of water resources department to extend farming opportunities. 2 kms of pipeline is being extended in different areas at the cost of 2 lakh 25 thousand rupees with the initiative of drinking water and sanitation department to extend drinking water facilities. Apart from this, two brick soling roads of 150 m and 200 m length respectively were constructed in the panchayat at the cost of 3 lakh 30 thousand rupees. This was informed by Amarpur Block Office.

Fishing nets distributed to fish farmers of Jampuihill block

In the financial year 2021-22, fishing nets were distributed to 20 beneficiary fish farmers of Jampuihill block with the initiative of Fisheries Supervisor's office, Kanchapur sub-division. Total expenditure for this was 44 thousand rupees. Among them, 2 fish farmers are of Manpui village, 2 are of Vanghmun village, 2 are of Tulangsang village, 6 are of Sabuyal village, 3 are of Longai Valley village and 2 fish farmers are of Kanpui village. Each farmer was provided one fishing net.

Pucca houses to 260 families of Chandpur ADC village under PMAY-G

Pucca houses are being constructed for 260 families of Chandpur ADC village of Hezamara block under Pradhan Mantri

Awas Yojana-Gramin. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees will be spent on construction of each house. Apart from that, permanent assets were created through different development works done in the village under MGNREGA in the financial year 2021-22. This includes pond excavation and repairing, agricultural land levelling and repairing, new road construction and repairing of old roads, creation of water irrigation sources etc. Total expenditure in implementation of all these projects was 98 lakh 50 thousand 607 rupees. 634 families have benefited through this. This was informed by Chandpur Village Office.

Pucca houses to 1,385 families of Poangbari block under PMAY-G

In the financial year 2021-22 under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin, Pucca houses are being constructed for 1 thousand 385 families of 7 Gram Panchayats and 3 ADC Villages of Poangbari block. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees will be spent on construction of each house. On the other hand, total 87 rural roads are being constructed in the present financial year under MGNREGA at the cost of 5 crore 21 lakh rupees.
