CM lays foundation for major road work in Belonia

The chief minister laid foundation stone for development of 30 km road from Kasharimukh to Gourangabazar in Rajnagar of Belonia subdivision block and inaugurated the newly built CMO office in Belonia today. An amount of Rs. 19.20 crore would be spent in construction of this road. Addressing the gathering on this occasion at the Belonia BKI H.S. School ground the chief said, the state government is showing a new direction of development in its two and half years of rule. He said, once the Moitri Setu over Feni river is completed a new avenue of economic development for the state would open up.

The chief minister said, by 2022 drinking water connections would be ensured in every household of the state under Atal

Jaldhara and so far drinking water connections have been given to 3,444 households under the scheme. under the Light House scheme 1000 flats will be constructed in 12 months time in Agartala. Additionally 1.70 lakh houses will be given to the needy people under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. He also shed lights on other development activities in the state. The programme was also attended by MLA Arun Chandra Bhowmik, MLA Shankar Roy, MLA Pramode Kakali Das Datta. Reang. Sabhadhipati of South Tripura Zilla Parishad presided over the occasion.

HIV screening in Kalyanpur

HIV screening of every local pregnant woman had been done in MCH clinic of Kalyanpur Community Health Centre under Ahana project on December 29, 2020. Regular health check-up of pregnant woman, nutrition, rest and institutional delivery have been emphasized in the camp. HIC test of 28 pregnant women was done in the camp. Report of all pregnant women came out negative. The officers of Ahana project discussed on awareness of AIDS in detail. Moreover, MPH, MPW, Extension Educator, District Media Expert, Lab-technician and ASHA workers were present in the camp. Director of family welfare and preventive medicine department has informed this in a press release.

Assistance for cultivation in Hadrai ADC village

Different development works are being implemented in Hadrai ADC village of Teliamura subdivision during the current financial year. Assistance has been provided by the agriculture and farmers' welfare department to the beneficiaries for plantation of Betel nut in 5 hectare land, cultivation of boro paddy in 20 hectare land under SRI system, cultivation of Mustard in 5 hectare land, cultivation o Ground nut in 2 hectare land, cultivation of Corn in 5 hectare land etc. Moreover, different services are being provided by the social education and social welfare department to 17 pregnant women and 80 children through three Anganwadi centres.
