

3rd phase of Covid-19 vaccination starts in Gomati district: D.M

The third phase of Covid-19 vaccination has started in Gomati district from 1st March, 2021. Medical staffs have been vaccinated in the 1st phase and other front line workers in the 2nd phase in the district. This process is still continuing. At first, the persons aged 60 years or above then the citizens between the age group of 45-59 years who are suffering from particular diseases (diseases marked by the Union Ministry of Health & Family Welfare) have been covered under Covid-19 vaccination in the third phase.

The persons suffering from 20 particular diseases (diseases marked by Union Health & Family Welfare Ministry) have been given priority to get Covid-19 vaccine. But all the persons aged 60 years or above could avail Covid-19 vaccination facility subject production of age proof. The senior citizens have to come along with birth certificate, Aadhaar card, voter ID card, driving license, smart card and co-mobility certificate etc. to get vaccinated. D.M Dr. T.K Debnath has informed this in a press meet held at conference hall of the office of D.M, Gomati district yesterday.

The CMO of Gomati district informed that Covid-19 vaccination is going on in total 17 hospitals of the district. 4887 persons have been administered 1st dose of Covid-19 vaccination. 2053 persons have been administered 2nd dose of Covid-19 vaccination. This process is still going on. 4335 persons have been administered 1st dose Covid-19 vaccination in 2nd phase. He also informed that de-worming tablet will be provided to the persons between the age group of 1-19 years from March 16 in the district on the occasion of National De-worming Day. In this period, the target of the district has been set to distribute de-worming tablet among 1 lakh 49 thousand 959 persons.

Special training camp on non-contagious diseases

A two-day long training camp was organised at Bishalgarh Subdivisional hospital for MPS and MPWs on public census base screening, UBPS and non-contagious. The training started from February 2. Dr. Biplab Modak, Dr. Nabanita Ghosh, Dr. Subrata Debbarma imparted training to the target trainees in batches of 30 each. Simultaneously training was started at Sonamura Community health centre also. Dr. Dipen Shankar De, Dr. Nilanjana Debbarma, Dr. Chandan Debnath, State level programme

officer Dr. Supriya Mallik and Gourav Bhattacharjee discussed on non-contagious diseases. Moreover, director of health and family welfare department Radha Debbarma provided award to the candidates who passed in the post test of non-contagious diseases screening. Mission Indra Dhanush 3.0 running in three districts

The first phase of Intensified Mission Indra Dhanush (IMI)-3.0 was started on February 22 in three districts of the state. Under the programme chief medical officer of every district along with other health workers including ASHAs conduct special vaccination drive.

During conduction of such vaccination COVID-19 guidelines are to be followed for which health centres have been directed to ensure good publicity.
