

Dal to be distributed in ration shops from September

The state government has decided to yet again to distribute Dal through ration shops in the state at affordable rates. This will be done after buying Dal from the open markets through e-tendering. Dal for August month will be given in September itself. Therefore, 2 months Dal will be available in September in ration shops. Each NFSA family will be given Dal at Rs 59/kg leaving the subsidy amount of Rs 25. APL families can buy at Rs 84/kg. Every kind of ration card will be liable for only 1kg Dal a month. This information was given by the Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs department.

5.96 lakh families under NFSA

Decisions have been taken to bring more poor APL families under National Food & Security Act in the state. Priority household and Antyodaya families will get 5 kg of rice per person and 35 kg on each card at Rs 2/kg under NFSA in the state. Accordingly, 67 thousand 508 beneficiaries of 19 thousand 39 APL families were registered freshly as Priority households from November 2020 to August 2021. These families will be given rice at subsidy from ration shops. Till date,

Training for animal rearing in Kanchanpur

A training camp on modern way of animal rearing was held in Kanchanpur sub division. 30 beneficiaries took part in the training program. This information was collected from the office of sub division ARDD department.

6371 persons getting social pensions in Amarpur

People are getting benefits of different schemes of ICDS of Social Welfare & Social Education department, Amarpur office, such as, 3 thousand 522 persons are getting old age pension, 597 are getting widow pension, 289 are getting Divyangan pension, 1 thousand 161 are getting girl child assistance scheme pension. Total 6 thousand 371 beneficiaries registered in 2020-21 are getting their monthly social pensions. Apart from that, 13 families under National Family Assistance scheme were given one-time assistance of twenty thousand rupees. 3 Divyangan couples were given one-time assistance of fifty

thousand rupees each under Special Marriage Grant scheme. 747 pregnant women under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana are getting grants in installments. This information was collected from ICDS supervisor Pancharatna Chakma.

Assistance provided to 8430 families in Jirania under MSPY

Assistance has been provided by Jirania agri-subdivision office to 8430 families of three blocks of Jirania subdivision for cultivation of vegetable and fruit under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. 2911 families of Jirania block, 2894 families of Belbari block and 2625 families of Old Agartala block in the subdivision have benefited under the scheme. Seeds of vegetable, saplings of betel nut, lemon and papaya have been provided to each beneficiary-family. The office of Jirania Agri- superintendant has informed this.

Sepahijala district level MSSSKA launched

A district level programme of Mukhyamantri Sustha Shaishab –Sustha Kaishore Abhiyan was launched at Bukhurai Community hall of Jampuijala subdivision in Sepahijala district on September 1, 2021. The programme was presided over by MLA cum Chairman of Jampuijala BAC Birendra Kishore Debbarma. Sabhadhipati of Zilla Parishad Supriya Das Datta, DM Biswashree B and district

education officer Habul Lodh were present in the programme. District welfare officer Dr. Arijit Sinha delivered welcome address. The guests fed de-worming tablets to ten children and adolescents. District welfare officer informed that one lakh seventy eight thousand one hundred thirty one children and adolescents will be covered under the scheme in the district. Vitamin A, ORS, Zinc, iron, folic acid, albendazole tablets will be fed to them. ASHA workers and Anganwadi staffs will provide these medicines at home.

Administrative cum health camp at Hejamara

An administrative-cum-health-camp was organized by Mohanpur subdivisional administration at the premises of Ramshankar ADC village office in Hejamara block. The administration issued income certificate to 33 persons in the camp. Moreover, the applications for 535 ST certificates, 512 PRTC, 186 birth certificates, 2 death certificates, 178 marriage certificates, registration or name separation in 53 ration cards, 24 properties related problems have been received in the camp. Required medicines were provided by the health department to 14 persons after medical checkup. Covid vaccine was administered to 9 persons. SDM of Mohanpur subdivision Subhash Datta, Addl.SDM Takhirai Debbarma, BDO of Hejamara block Kamal Debbarma and officer of subdivision level different departments were present in the camp.
