

Web portal launched for Tripura Sundari Temple

The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb officially launched the web portal of Mata Tripura Sundari Temple today. The portal was launched with a view to bringing about transparency in donation process as well as giving visual access to the devotees across the world. During the launching programme held at the video conference hall of the state secretariat, secretary of the revenue department Tanushree Debbarma, special secretary Sharadindu Choudhury, director of information and cultural affairs department Ratan Biswas and OSD of Mata Tripura Sundari Trust Bhaskar Dasgupta were present.

In this context talking to the media persons the chief minister said that with this initiative a glorious chapter has begun for the people of the state. Through this portal everyday from 11 am to 1 pm. devotees could see the goddess Tripura Sundari online, which nobody could imagine earlier. At the same time people could now onward do online booking from 4-5 am. for entering the temple. People from any part of the world also could now donate for the temple.

The chief minister also mentioned that the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India has sanctioned Rs. 38 crore for the development of Matabari. Through a project beautification of Matabari, foot bridge construction, shed-equipped pathways for the pilgrims, rope way from Udaipur rail station to Matabari etc. activities will be taken up. Recently a handloom stall was opened in the Matabari premises so that the pilgrims could collect beautiful Risa while visiting the temple. Solar street lights and study lamps given in Dhalai district

1182 New solar lights have been installed by the science, technology and environment department in different ADC villages of four Aspirational Blocks of Dhalai district in association with Tripura Renewable Energy Development Agency. Installation of 903 more street lights is going on. Under the scheme, 400 street lights in Dumboornagar block, 12 street lights in Ganganagar block, 37 street lights in Raishyabari block and 620 street lights in Chhamanu block have been installed.

Moreover, solar study lamps have been provided to a total of 17, 214 students of 201 schools of the four blocks. Among them solar study lamps have been provided to 5980 students of 68 schools in Dumboornagar block, 1576 students of 44 schools in Ganganagar block, 2551 students of 43 schools in Raishyabari block and 7107 students of 26 schools in Chhamanu block. The officer concerned in Tripura Renewable Energy Development Agency has informed this.

Assistance for Pisciculture in Kathalia block area

Various works are being implemented by the fisheries department to increase fish production in Kathalia block area in the current fiscal year. Fish fingerlings were distributed to 229 families of the block in the present year spending total 5 lakh 80 thousand 114 rupees. It was informed by the fisheries department, Kathalia office that fish fingerlings of various species were distributed to 206 families of the block for mixed fish farming spending 2 lakh 23 thousand rupees. Fish fingerlings of various species and prawns were distributed to 3 families spending 1 lakh 11 thousand 714 rupees. Fish fingerlings of various species including Pabda were distributed to 5 families spending 1 lakh 64 thousand 500 rupees.

Similarly, fish spawns were given to 15 families spending 80 thousand 900 rupees. Ponds will be excavated for 3 fish farmer families under Blue Revolution spending 1 lakh 56 thousand 800 rupees. Apart from this, one fish trader will be given one auto rickshaw and ice box for selling fish spending 2 lakh rupees. It was also informed by the block office that 75 farmers were trained to increase fish production by fish farming in scientific way where 25 fish farmers were given one day training and 50 fish farmers were given 3-day training.

Bi-cycles distributed among girl students

Bi-cycles have been distributed by the education department among the girl students of class – IX in Sonamura H.S. Girls Schools during the academic year 2019-20. The bi-cycle distribution programme was inaugurated by MLA Subhash Chandra Das recently. The chairman of Tripura Waqaf Board Baharul Islam Majumder, SDM, Sonamura subdivision Subrata Majumder, chairman of School SMC Committee Salim Majumder were also present on the occasion. In total 366 girl students of 11 schools received bi-cycles in the subdivision.
